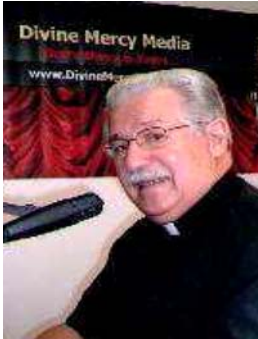

Very Reverend Canon Thomas J. Skindeleski has a Bachelors of Arts from St. Mary's College; a Masters in Secondary Educational Administration, and a Masters of Divinity.
