The Divine Mercy Presentation



Our presentations cover every aspect of the Divine Mercy devotion including these:

The **Image of The Divine Mercy** has a rich and interesting history which is covered in detail and images of different sizes will be made available after the presentation.

The **Chaplet of Divine Mercy** is thoroughly explained, its benefits are made known, and then everyone is led in reciting the Divine Mercy Chaplet during the presentation.

The **Novena of Chaplets** of Divine Mercy and its origins will be explained so that a good understanding of it will bring about a greater participation for the Feast of Mercy.

The **Hour of Mercy** that the Lord Jesus said was a very important time to meditate on His Passion and Death and the promises that He made concerning this hour will be covered.

The **Feast of Mercy** (Divine Mercy Sunday) will be thoroughly explained in such a way that everyone will come to understand that this feast is God's greatest gift for our time. We will show you how you can best use this feast to get many Easter-only & fallen-away Catholics back to the practice of their faith.

How long are the presentations?

The presentations themselves are about 90 minutes long which are usually followed by a short Question and Answer period and later by an opportunity to purchase popular devotional items such as booklets, books, leaflets, pictures, CDs, and DVDs.

Total time from start to finish is usually somewhere around 3 hours, outside of the initial set-up and breakdown time.

How to organize a Presentation

To set-up a Divine Mercy Presentation, give us a call at our ministry office in Port Saint Lucie, Florida. We will let you know how to get started and what you will need to do.

Some things to consider:

Location: The presentation is most effective in a church. We use a Divine Mercy Image and always pay reverence to and focus on the true presence of Jesus in the Tabernacle. We ask that tables be set-up in a suitable area, perhaps in a hall, so that parishioners can easily find us after the presentation to obtain the devotional items to take home.

Support: We are supported exclusively on the donations from parishes and individuals. A stipend if the parish can afford it, will be very helpful toward our ministry's success. A free-will collection might be beneficial.

Travel: It is always helpful when the travel expenses are compensated by the parish. If we are also presenting in a nearby parish, the travel expenses can be shared by them also.

Accommodations: We deeply appreciate any accommodations for our husband and wife team. We can stay in any hotel, but we also enjoy staying with others in their home.
